Open to all ages, levels and styles, SIM's innovative and intensive workshops feature week-long sessions carefully planned but informally structured to facilitate a healthy, stimulating atmosphere for creative musical exploration.

Modeled after the relaxed settings in which improvising musicians typically collaborate, SIM's flexible environment enables students both to focus intensely and to interact freely with top professionals drawn from New York City's jazz and creative music circles.

WORKING METHOD

The SIM intensive focuses on exploring the process of improvisation through discussion and master classes. SIM sessions emphasize playing contexts ranging from free improvisational structures, original compositions, and jazz standards to offer participants a diverse experience.

WORKSHOP DETAILS

The workshop includes four weekly master classes, ensemble rehearsals and student and faculty concerts. In addition, each week participants receive 2 private lessons.

Students and faculty come together to form a unique artistic community. Developing musicians take part in collective and individual artistic discovery, with the guidance, inspiration, and partnership of established musical innovators.
